Preacceptance Checklist

The following checklist is intended to provide system owners, project managers, and other information system development and maintenance professionals with guidance in preparation for the acceptance activities. Initiation of acceptance activities begins with successful completion of the system testing.

Information systems acceptance preparation is generally characterized as a process to ensure everything is in place to begin the acceptance process activities.

The Preacceptance Checklist helps to ensure that all necessary preparatory activities have been completed and that the required operating documents were developed and approved.
