Enclosed is the Department of Energy's (DOE) Fiscal Year (FY) 2009 Annual Performance Report on its activities to assist Tribal College and Universities (TCUs). DOE is submitting this information in accordance with Executive Order 13270.

In FY2009, DOE provided \$105,500 in total expenditures for (TCUs), an increase of \$63,983 over the amounts provided to TCUs in FY 2008. In an effort to raise the level of support in future years, DOE will continue to set funding goals and to identify opportunities for additional partnerships with TCUs. DOE is developing a Department-wide strategy to involve TCUs in science and technology programs. We are also working with DOE's National Laboratories to increase our support for TCUs in the areas of science and technology research. DOE remains committed to supporting the President's Executive Order on TCUs.

I look forward to continuing to work with you and the White House Initiative Office on TCUs to prepare students for the future science and technical workforce.

PART A: EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Department of Energy is committed to ensuring Tribal Colleges and Universities (TCUs) receive the support necessary to enhance their ability to provide excellence in education.

- 1. In FY 2009 the Department of Energy continued to support four established principal objectives as indicated below:
 - a. Develop and establish supporting infrastructure that will foster and improve the implementation of the Three-Year Plans, and to support the Department's American Indian and Alaskan Native Tribal Government Policy to "initiate a coordinated Department-wide effort for technical assistance, business and economic self determination development opportunities, education, and training programs."
 - b. Develop and implement programs or activities that strengthen and sustain the capacity of TCUs to compete effectively for available grants, contracts, cooperative agreements, and other Federal resources;
 - c. Establish collaborative research and development partnerships in conjunction with National Laboratories and appropriate scientific facilities connected with TCUs;
 - d. Establish Department-wide funding goals to ensure opportunities for TCUs and other minority educational institutions to participate in the programs of the Department.
- 2. In an effort to increase DOE's support to TCUs, the Office of Economic Impact and Diversity, in partnership with the Office of Health and Safety and Security Performance, will continue to support the Cooperative Agreement with Fort Peck Community College and Salish Kootenai College. This cooperative agreement is in the amount of \$500,000 over a 5 year period. This support includes assisting in education and training activities of academically talented Native American students attending TCUs, specifically Fort Peck Community College and Salish Kootenai College through the establishment of an academic achievement program with specific focus on energy careers. This program is developed for the purpose of increasing these students' awareness of energy-related careers, business development, and to continue their pursuit of these disciplines and careers in order to ensure an adequate supply of manpower for the accomplishment of energy research and development programs.
- 3. DOE, in partnership with other federal agencies is planning a Technical Assistance Workshop in early 2010 to inform TCUs of other DOE and federal agency program opportunities.
- 4. The Department of Energy provided \$105,500 in FY2009 for TCUs.
- 5. Department of Energy funding to Tribal Colleges and Universities (TCUs) increased from FY2008 to FY2009 in the amount of \$63,983.
