**REQUEST FOR DATA**

**Date issued:** March 2, 2010

On January 11, 2010, the Department of Energy (DOE or the Department) received information regarding Delta Faucet's showerhead model "In2ition 75582" indicating that testing of this model demonstrated that it exceeds the Federal maximum water flow rate requirement.

DOE's regulations for enforcement, contained in 10 CFR §430.70, state that DOE may conduct enforcement testing of a covered product upon receiving information in writing that a particular covered product may not be in compliance with the applicable performance standard. The first step of this procedure is for the Department to examine the manufacturer's test data.

In accordance with 10 CFR § 430.62(d), the Department requests that Delta Faucet submit the test data, including a complete test report, for model "In2ition 75582" to Laura Barhydt via email at [Laura.Barhydt@hq.doe.gov](mailto:Laura.Barhydt@hq.doe.gov), no later than March 15, 2010. If you would like to meet with representatives of the Department to discuss the compliance of these models, please suggest a suitable date.

DOE notes that it has received a certification report for this showerhead model from Alsons Corporation, a sister company to Delta Faucet. The certification report lists the flow rate for model number 75582 as 2.5gpm.

Companies are prohibited from distributing in commerce any covered product not in compliance with the applicable DOE energy conservation standard. Any person who knowingly violates this provision may be subject to fines of up to \$200 per violation, i.e., per product distributed in the United States. 42 U.S.C. 6303.
