Making Our Contract Governance Structure Work

- Procurement Contracting Officer
 - Manages the M&O contract terms and conditions
 - Ensures consistency across the complex & compliance with Federal & DOE requirements
- Administrative Contracting Officers
 - Enforce the M&O contract terms and conditions
 - Delegations – Contract admin functions at FAR 42.302
 - **Issue Work Authorizations & monitor performance**
 - Issue Interagency Agreements (WFO/SPP)
 - Manage the award fee process



Work Authorization Improvement

- WAs are an ordering instrument
- Should provide definitive scope, cost & schedule
 - Generally tied to an implementation plan (IP)
 - IPs varying widely in quality
- Issuing WA NNSA supplemental directive
- NA-APM to monitor compliance

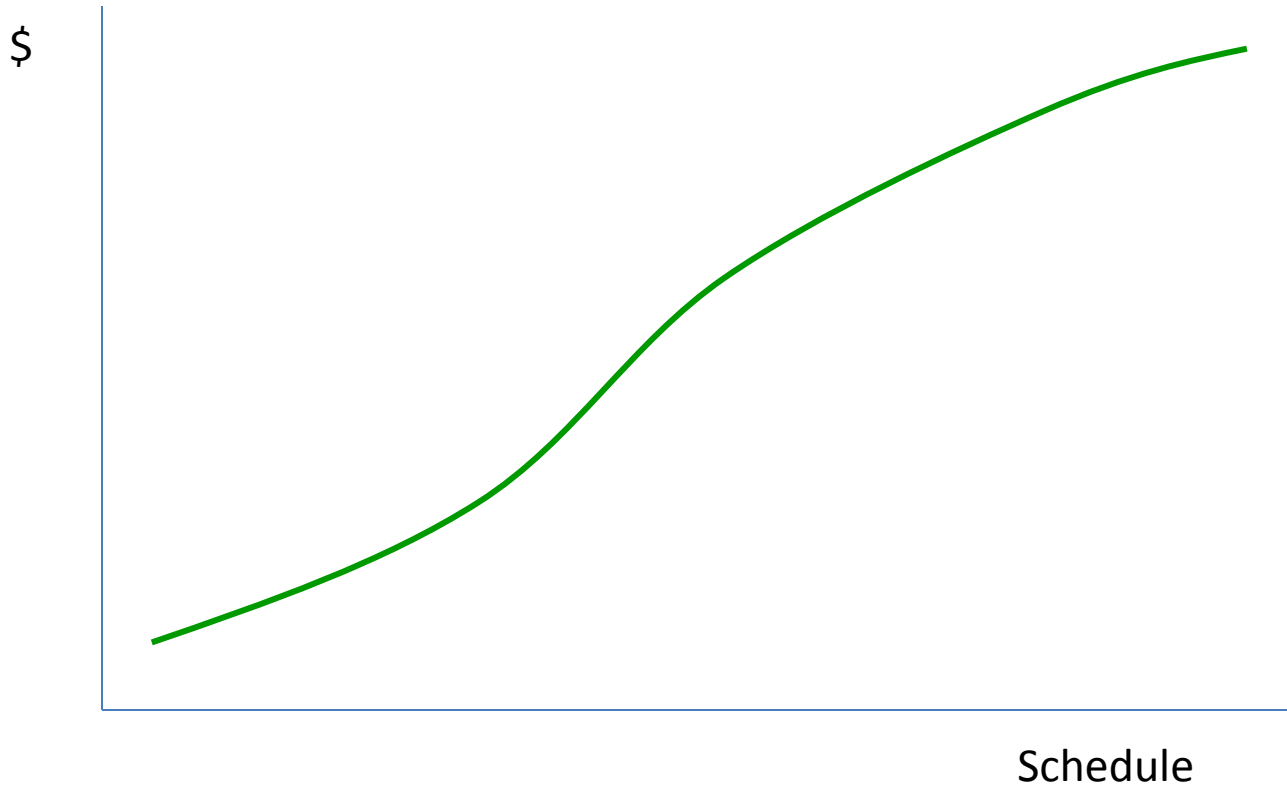


Improving Capital Project Delivery

- Use of standard construction terms & conditions
- Greater use of FFP contracting
- Use of multi-year incentives
 - Tying fee to successful delivery at CD-4
- Ensuring we are properly staffed
 - Ability to look under the hood
 - No big surprises

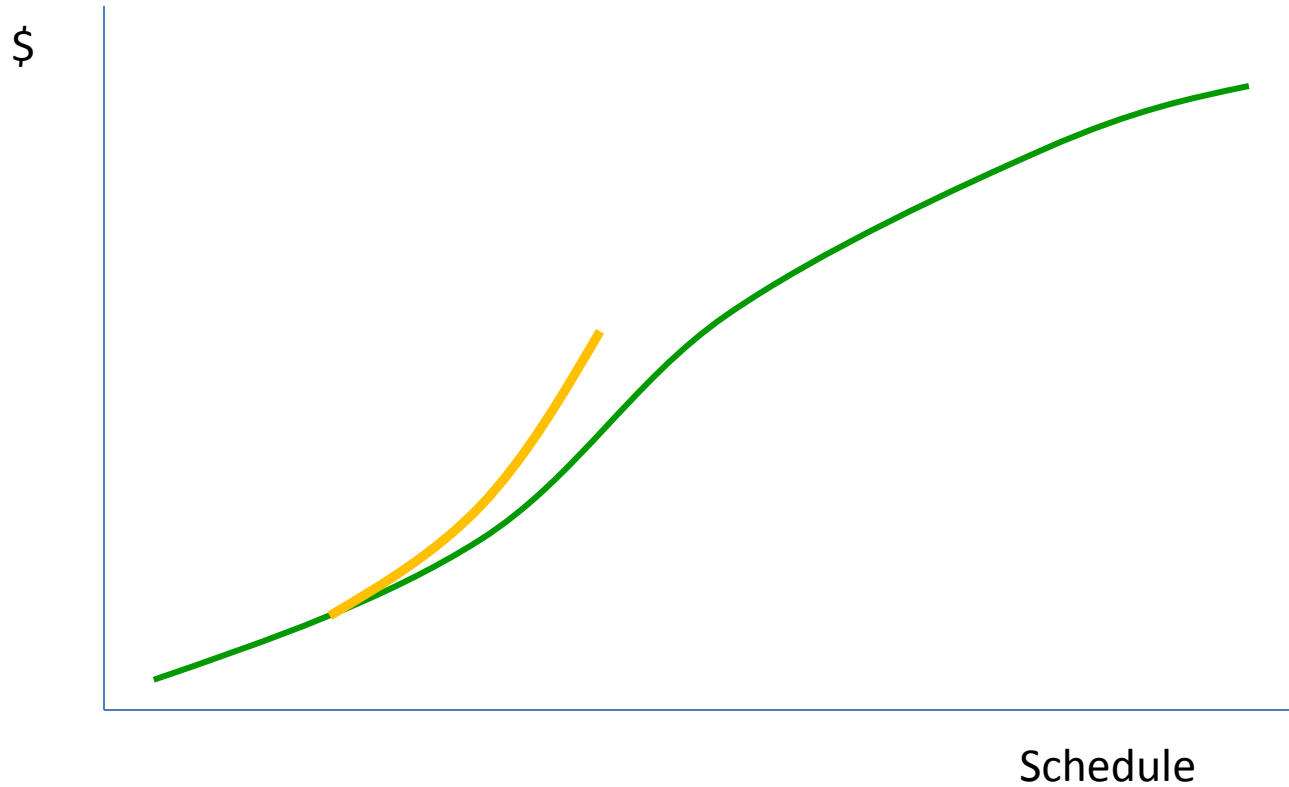


Estimate Project Costs



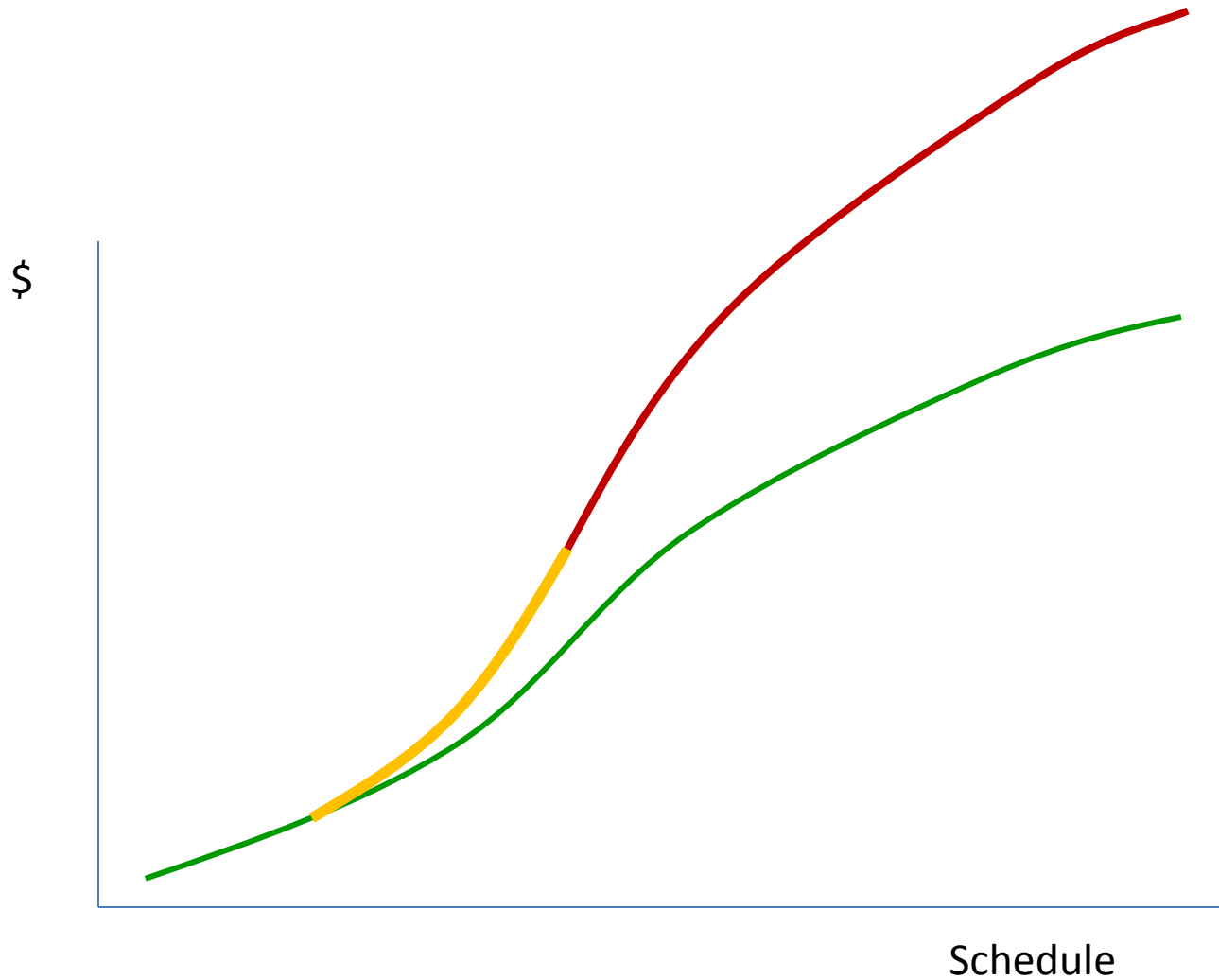


Project is “Yellow”
