SUBJECT: Requisitions in STRIPES

SUMMARY: This Policy Flash disseminates updated guidance to STRIPES users on the use of requisitions for STRIPES actions. STRIPES users will no longer be required to do a requisition for every action initiated in STRIPES.

Administrative modifications which have no effect on award value or obligations (as reflected in the respective STRIPES fields) can be performed without requiring a requisition unless there is a local procedure which requires a requisition. However, some non-monetary actions such as the issuance of Change Orders and the Exercise of Options will still require a Requisition so that the Procurement Action Lead Times (PALT) is tracked for Balanced Scorecard (BSC) purposes.

STRIPES documentation and user manuals will be updated to reflect the above change as soon as possible.
