required to install temperature monitoring instrumentation on the BH 36 inch crude oil pipeline at valve stations 8PL00-MOV-02, 8PL00-MOV-04, 8PL00-MOV-05, and 8PL00-MOV-05,

MOV-15. Tasks include installation of thermocouples, transmitters, and cables.

## 10 CFR 1021.410 (Application of Categorical Exclusions)

- 2. Require siting and construction or major expansion of waste storage, disposal, recovery, or treatment facilities, but the proposal may include categorically excluded waste storage, disposal, recovery, or treatment actions.
- Disturb hazardous substances, pollutants, contaminants, or CERCLA-excluded petroleum and /natural gas products that preexist in the environment such that would be uncontrolled or unpermitted releases; or
- 4. Adversely affect environmentally sensitive resources.

## Categorical Exclusion to be applied: B5.2

Modifications to existing pump and piping configurations (including, but not limited to, manifolds, metering systems, and other instrumentation on such configurations conveying materials such as air, brine, carbon dioxide, geothermal system fluids, hydrogen gas, natural gas, nitrogen gas, oil, produced water, steam, and water). Covered modifications would not have the potential to cause significant changes to design process flow rates or permitted air emissions.
