Rationale for determination:

The Department of Energy (DOE) is proposing to provide funding to U.S. Army: Aberdeen Proving Ground in support of the proposed Aberdeen Proving Ground 8 MW Combined Heat and Power (CHP) Installation. This project was selected by DOE under the Assisting Federal Facilities with Energy Conservation Technologies (AFFECT) Funding Opportunity Announcement (DE-FOA-0000901).

The proposed project has not been defined to the extent that DOE can complete a final NEPA determination at this time. DOE has determined that Tasks 1.1 through 1.6 of the proposed project would not have a significant individual or cumulate impact to human health and/or the environment. Further, DOE has determined that Tasks 1.1 - 1.6 are consistent with CX A9 "Information gathering, analysis and dissemination" and are categorically excluded from further NEPA review.
