Energy Security and Electric Industry Restructuring Forum
With partial funding from DOE, the Consumer Energy Council of America
convened a blue-ribbon group of electric industry including state legislators,
regulators, and energy officials; Federal officials; consumer and environmental
representatives; Congressional staff; and academic experts to build a consensus set
of electric policy recommendations for public officials.
