# Energy Policy Act of 2005

- Energy Policy Act of 2005, Public Law 109-58
- > TITLE IX RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT
- Subtitle J Ultra-Deepwater and Unconventional Natural Gas and Other Petroleum Resources
- Sec. 999 Ultra-deepwater and unconventional onshore natural gas and other petroleum research and development program
- ➤ Signed into Law August 8, 2005

#### Section 999: Advisory Committees

- Advise the Secretary of Energy on development and implementation of activities related to:
  - Ultra-Deepwater Program (Ultra-Deepwater Advisory Committee [UDAC])
    - Include Committee sunset activities
  - Unconventional Resources Program (Unconventional Resources Technology Advisory Committee [URTAC])
- Responsibilities
  - Review annual plans
  - Make recommendations

# Program Milestones

August 2005	Energy Policy Act of 2005 signed into law [P.L. 109-58, 119 Stat. 922]
JANUARY 2007	Contract with Research to Secure Energy for America (RPSEA) as the Program consortium goes into effect (calendar year contract)
AUGUST 2007	2007 Annual Plan published; DOE/Fossil Energy (FE) receives FY07 funds; RPSEA receives initial research funding
JUNE 2008	Technical Committee [Section 999H(d)(4)] determines that the NETL Complementary Research Program is not duplicative of the consortium-administered program
AUGUST 2008	2008 Annual Plan published and delivered to Congress
DECEMBER 2008	2009 Annual Plan published and delivered to Congress
AUGUST 2009	Technical Committee meets

## Program Milestones

**DECEMBER 2009** 2010 Annual Plan published and delivered to Congress

APRIL 2010 MACONDO EXPLOSION: 11 LIVES LOST

July 2010 Technical Committee meets

**AUGUST 2011** 2011 Annual Plan published and delivered to Congress

**SEPTEMBER 2011** Technical Committee meets

JULY 2012 Technical Committee meets

August 2012 2012 Annual Plan published and delivered to Congress

## Committee Responsibilities

- > The primary responsibilities of the Committee are:
  - Advise the Secretary of Energy on the "... development and implementation of activities related to unconventional natural gas and other petroleum resources ..."
  - Review the Annual Plan and provide written comments, findings and recommendations to the Secretary of Energy
  - The Committee does not provide recommendations to other bodies or discuss Committee business with the press

## Committee Responsibilities

- Other responsibilities of the Committee include:
  - Committee members may not speak <u>in an official capacity</u> outside Committee meetings
    - Members are free to talk to Congress and Administration officials as individuals on matters not related to the work of the URTAC
  - The Committee does not review proposals submitted under RPSEA solicitations, nor recommend awards
  - RPSEA is a contractor of the U.S. Department of Energy and does not report to the URTAC
  - Members may not advise both RPSEA and the Secretary of Energy at the same time

#### 2013 Annual Plan Review Process

- **▶ SEPTEMBER 25, 2012** 
  - Establish ad-hoc Review Subcommittees
  - Each Subcommittee will meet to develop draft findings and draft recommendations for the URTAC
  - Subcommittee meetings are held via conference calls and/or WebEx
    - DOE provides logistics and support services for such meetings

#### 2013 Annual Plan Review Process

- **▶** OCTOBER 24 25, 2012; HOUSTON, TEXAS
  - Subcommittees present their reports to the URTAC
  - URTAC develops final findings and recommendations on the 2013 Annual Plan
  - Chair appoints Editing Subcommittee to develop the URTAC's written report
    - Editing Subcommittee may not change the letter or spirit of the URTAC findings or recommendations
  - Editing Subcommittee begins meeting immediately after the URTAC meeting adjourns

#### 2013 Annual Plan Review Process

- > Conference Call Meeting on November 1, 2012
  - URTAC meets via conference call to vote on the Editing Subcommittee report
  - Chair delivers the URTAC final recommendations to the Secretary of Energy via the Designated Federal Officer (DFO)

## Next Steps

- > September 25, 2012: Begin review
- October 24 25, 2012: Deliberate on recommendations
- November 1, 2012: Vote on Editing Subcommittee report
