Unconventional Resources Technology Advisory Committee (URTAC) Meeting Teleconference, October 27, 2011

At 11:00 a.m., the Committee Chair, Jeff Hall, called the meeting to order. Ms. Elena Melchert, Acting Designated Federal Officer (DFO) until Deputy Assistant Secretary Christopher Smith arrived, called the roll of the members. Committee members in attendance were: Kenneth Bromfield, Nancy Brown, Wayne Camp, Jessica Cavens, James Dwyer, Jeff Hall, Chris Hall, Bob Hardage, Robert Kleinberg, Fletcher Lewis, Amy Mall, John Martin, Greg Mason, Shahab Mohaghegh, Gary Nilson, Ken Oglesby, Don Sparks, and Sam Whitney. Absent from the meeting were: Dan Arthur, John Harju, and Brady Rodgers. Eighteen members were present, exceeding the minimum of twelve members required for a quorum.

Attending the meeting in Washington, D.C. was: Chris Smith, DFO, Elena Melchert, Committee Manager (CM) and Rob Matey of IBM, meeting recorder. There were no members of the public in attendance.

The CM began the next order of business by discussing key URTAC administrative topics. Ms. Melchert discussed several Section 999 activities that have taken place since the last Committee meeting in October, and planned activities for the *2012 Annual Plan* (Attachment 1). She finished by explaining the activities the Committee would undertake until the end of the program in 2014, including possible membership reappointments for the next and final term of URTAC. The CM's discussion was followed by some brief discussion by the members about the timing of the funding in the current and future "plan" years.

The Chair next introduced Christopher Smith, Deputy Assistant Secretary, Office of Oil and Natural Gas, to give an update on shale gas and other unconventional oil and gas activities. Mr. Smith discussed President Obama's challenge to reduce the amount of oil and gas the U.S. imports by one-third and how the reduction can be achieved. The DFO then discussed the National Commission on the BP Deepwater Horizon Oil Spill and Offshore Drilling and the Secretary of Energy Advisory Board (SEAB). He explained how the SEAB Subcommittee is trying to employ good, reliable science to develop solid recommendations to the Secretary of Energy to show the community that their concerns are being heard and taken seriously. Mr. Smith also mentioned the National Petroleum Council (NPC) recently released a major new report entitled *Prudent Development: Realizing the Potential of North America's Abundant Natural Gas and Oil Resources* which has a lot of overlap with the SEAB recommendations. The Department of Energy counts on these committees' diversity and knowledgeable advice to provide solid, actionable recommendations.

Following the DFO's remarks, a brief Committee discussion took place regarding the DOE oil and gas budget, or lack thereof, the proposed repeal of Section 999. The DFO explained to the Committee that all monies are being scrutinized due to the current theme of deficit reduction in Congress, but there are no foregone conclusions. As there was no further business, the Chair closed the meeting by thanking the members, the DFO, the CM, and the staff for the informative meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 11:55 a.m.
