Context

- Tribal Use of GSA Comes from Various Authorities
- GSA has no International or Tribal Affairs Office
 - Support to Tribes can be complex and difficult to assess
 - There is no singular subject matter expert
 - Authorities of use are diverse



GSA and Federally-Recognized Tribes

- October 16, 2012, GSA Office of Government-wide Policy: "Our office no longer regularly handles eligibility determination requests regarding Native American Tribes and Tribal Organizations."
- Sponsoring/Granting Agencies Verify Eligibility to Use GSA in Accordance with Applicable Authorities (BIA, HUD, IHS, USDA)



The Two Primary Authorities

- ➤ P.L. 93-638 Indian Self-Determination & Education Act
 - Contract Schools
 - Hospitals/Clinics
 - Tribal Programs
 - Grant Schools (P.L. 100-297 Tribally Controlled Schools Act of 1988)

"Tribal entities need to comply with their own internal procurement policies when placing orders through GSA MAS vendors. For NAHASDA funds, Indian Preference applies and is subject to compliance audits by HUD. Several Indian-owned enterprises and Alaska Native Corporations are GSA MAS schedule holders and would meet the requirement of Indian Preference. Indian preference may or may not apply for BIA and IHS funds depending on what internal procurement policies a tribe has in place."



For Federally-owned space managed by GSA's Public Building Service (PBS), approval of the PBS Building Manager must be received by the ordering activity and contractor before any repair and alteration work may be ordered. A copy of the approval must be retained by both the ordering activity contracting officer and the contractor. Owned or leased space outside the PBS inventory may also include approval requirements. A copy of the approval must be retained by both the ordering activity contracting officer and the MAS contractor performing the R&A services. This R&A SIN shall not be used for PBS leased space. Any Agency contracting officer ordering services under this SIN for Ancillary Repair and Alterations is responsible for complying with his or her agency's internal policies when procuring R&A services. This may include a specific warrant delegation for procuring construction services when the estimated amount of this portion of the task order exceeds \$2,000 (Ref. FAR 22.4). Special Notice to Ordering Agencies: GSA or other landlords may require re-performance of any nonconforming work at agency expense. If applicable, agencies may seek appropriate recourse from the contractor responsible for the nonconforming work.
