RE: Alternative Route AR 5-B

We the undersigned strongly oppose the Plains and Eastern Clean Line updated application as published in the Federal Register. No privately owned company, their partners, cooperatives or subcontractors should be given the power to use Section 1222 of the Energy act (the use of eminent domain to take land from hard working landowners without their consent) for the company's own personal gain. The safety to persons and property in the Fayetteville Shale Play area issues raised by the potential siting of an HVDC Transmission line near Natural Gas Gathering Pipelines and Production Equipment have not been studied or identified and how they would be dealt with. The safety to persons and Air Force Pilots in the area issues raised by the potential siting of an HVDC Transmission line in the Little Rock Air Force Base Low Level Training Flight paths in Arkansas have not been studied or identified. Health issues have not been fully studied and how the lines will affect persons with cancer, pacemakers, hearing aids, and what affect the aerial spraying of herbicides and toxins will have on people, animals and the environment. EMF's (electromagnetic fields) have not been fully studied and identified as to what affect it will have. Loud corona noise from the transmission lines needs to be studied on how it will devalue property, cause hearing problems, disturb the peace and disturb the wildlife habitat. Decreased property values have not been fully studied and how it will affect not only the landowners but also the surrounding property landowners. The safety to landowners, their families, their neighbors, their animals and their property near the proposed power lines has not been fully studied or identified if a tornado were to occur in the path of the proposed line. We ask that DOE take into consideration all of the reasons for this opposition and NOT partner with Plains and Eastern on the previous or updated proposal for HVDC Transmission Lines.
