The National Nuclear Security Administration's Uranium Processing Facility Site Readiness Subproject Team

The Uranium Processing Facility (UPF) Site Readiness Subproject Team is recognized for delivering the first UPF subproject \$20 million under budget and on schedule in February 2015. Successful completion of the \$65M UPF Site Readiness Subproject represents a significant step towards achieving NNSA's commitment to completing the UPF Project and ceasing enriched uranium programmatic operations in Building 9212 (1) by 2025, and (2) for a cost not to exceed \$6.5 billion. The project team used the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) as the construction manager, which allowed NNSA to (1) reduce project costs and risks, (2) advance the Deputy Secretary's policy to align contract incentives with taxpayer interests, and (3) leverage core USACE strengths, including its experience with infrastructure construction and using firm fixed-price construction contracts.
