Description:

- A11 Technical advice and planning assistance to international, national, state, and local organizations.
- B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The following activities fall outside the bounds of the signed SOW, or were not included in the signed SOW, but qualify for a categorical exclusion under NEPA:

#5 Building Energy Efficiency Projects – Public Works (subactivities: hot water heat system transfer improvements, improved closed-loop refrigeration, central plant boiler upgrades and alternate cooling). These activities are categorically excluded under NEPA under B5.1

#6 – Building EE Projects – Parks. While some components of the project fall within the bounds of the SOW (lighting, windows, HVAC), other components (roof coating, envelope replacement, replacement of ice refrigeration package controls) fall outside the bounds of the SOW. However, these activities are categorically excluded under NEPA under B5.1

#9 Server Virtualization. The proposed server upgrades to conserve energy fall outside the established retrofit bounds

of the SOW but are categorically excluded under NEPA under B5.1

#12 - Plant/Life Sciences Pre-Incubator Retrofits would utilize EECBG funds for energy efficiency improvements for the HVAC, lighting, and electrical systems in conjunction with a building retrofit project at a building planned to provide space for plant and life science corporations. Funds would cover replacement costs for systems consistent with current office use but be limited to the differential cost between standard equipment and higher efficiency systems for changed use/additional capacity. This activity is categorically excluded under NEPA under B5.1.

#18 Fleet Green Vehicles includes the purchase of fuel efficient hybrid vehicles in lieu of less fuel efficient standard sedans and is categorically excluded under NEPA under B5.1.

#21 Project Oversight. The proposed project oversight activity is categorically excluded under NEPA under A9 and
