Rational for determination:

The Illinois Department of Commerce & Economic Opportunity will provide \$520,000 of Recovery Act funds to Heidtman Steel Products in improve plant operations. The funds will be used to purchase and install equipment in the redesign of the current process layout. Heidtman Steel is located in Granite City, Illinois. The plant provides steel for the wind energy industry.

The equipment to be installed includes a longer stacker and runout table on the steel sheet processing equipment, a new measuring table, three cranes, a transfer cart, and new rail and pathway to link the sheet facility with the processing facility. Some of the plant redesign efforts may involve the relocation of equipment from another facility, such as the cranes.

This activity comprises actions to install new equipment, redesign the layout of process operations, and relocate selected equipment and machinery. The redesign efforts are intended to improve process operations and improve energy conservation by increasing manufacturing efficiency in the facility. Based on the information provided by the State and recipient, this activity is consistent with categorical exclusion B1.31 and B5.1.
