Description:

B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.

Rational for determination:

The State of Colorado will provide \$210,000 to B&H Industries to install a 100kW ground-mounted PV system at a livestock feeding facility located at Rocky Ford Feedyard, 30611 County Rd. 16, Rocky Ford, CO.

The solar array covers an area approximately 640x100ft and will be ground mounted. The area where the PV array will be located has been used for cattle grazing; the area adjacent is for cattle grazing. Beyond that, the area is primarily farmland. The site is located about 40 miles east of Pueblo. The terrain is fairly flat.

The project layout consists of 504 crystalline 200W solar PV modules arranged in 18 ground-mounted arrays of 28 modules each with 38 degree fixed tilt facing true south. The total DC rating will feed to a SatCon 100kW DC-to-AC inverter then to the service panel for the facility. The output from the solar array will be used to supply the electrical needs of the facility.

Based on information provided by the State and recipient, the work outlined is consistent with activities identified in Categorical Exclusion B5.1.
