Description:

- B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.

Rational for determination:

The Illinois Department of Commerce & Economic Opportunity will provide \$250,000 in Recovery Act funds to Balanced Wind, LLC to purchase and install equipment used in the manufacturing of vertical axis wind turbines. The equipment will be installed at Balanced Wind's new manufacturing plant, which is to be located in a currently vacant 90,000 square foot facility in Chicago, Illinois. Balanced Wind intends to retrofit the building, move manufacturing operations into the new space, and achieve LEED status for the building.

This activity comprises actions to improve energy conservation and energy efficiency by installing equipment to manufacture wind turbines in a to-be-constructed LEED-designed facility. The work identified is consistent with provision identified within Categorical Exclusion B5.1 and B1.31.
