Description:

- A9** Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, audits), data analysis (including computer modeling), document preparation (such as conceptual design or feasibility studies, analytical energy supply and demand studies), and dissemination (including, but not limited to, document mailings, publication, and distribution; and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring.
- B3.1** Onsite and offsite site characterization and environmental monitoring, including siting, construction (or modification), operation, and dismantlement or closing (abandonment) of characterization and monitoring devices and siting, construction, and associated operation of a small-scale laboratory building or renovation of a room in an existing building for sample analysis. Activities covered include, but are not limited to, site characterization and environmental monitoring under CERCLA and RCRA. Specific activities include, but are not limited to:
- B3.3** Field and laboratory research, inventory, and information collection activities that are directly related to the conservation of fish or wildlife resources and that involve only negligible habitat destruction or population reduction

Rational for determination:

DOE funding for this award will be used to perform feasibility studies for future development of tidal power in the Puget Sound, WA. The project will also involve developing deployment strategies, outreach/consultation activities to obtain required permits and responsibly evaluate the environmental effects of the Admiralty Inlet pilot plant under grant (DE-FG36-08GO18169). The specific scope of the proposed work will be defined by feedback from stakeholders/agencies following the submission of the District's Draft License Application (DLA) to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) in December 2009. Snohomish County PUD will have the results evaluated in conjunction with regulatory agencies, tribal governments, and other project stakeholders.

Tasks for this project include:

Task 1 - Environmental and Regulatory Activities

Environmental studies - habitat assessment, water quality, marine mammal, seabird, fish, bathymetrical, geotechnical, and electromagnetic field studies. Field studies being continued from the previous award (DE-FG36-08GO18169) include multibeam hydrographic and sidescan sonar surveys; water quality sampling; hydroacoustic and fish distribution studies; and field surveys of cultural and tribal resources.

Regulatory activities - agency, tribal, and stakeholder consultation; permit and license preparation; pre-installation and project monitoring study plan development. No animal collection, testing or tagging will take place during the habitat assessments.

Task 2 - Management and Reporting

Generation of: Reports, Briefings, Presentations, Applications for Applicable Permits, and the Development of Strategies and Guidelines for future deployment of tidal power in the Puget Sound, WA.

This project will not involve the final design of a tidal power system nor any construction/destruction related activities. Activities will be limited to environmental monitoring, data gathering, and report generation.

This project does not pose a significant impact to human or natural environment, this project is hereby Categoricaly Excluded from further NEPA review under A9 "Information Gathering" and B3.1 "Environmental Monitoring", and B3.3 "Research Related to Wildlife Conservation".
