Description:

B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The State of Louisiana will provide \$3,250,000 in Recovery Act funds to Lamar Advertising of Louisiana, LLC (Lamar) to install a combination of wind- and solar-powered systems to billboards located across the State. Lamar is located at 4171 Essen Lane, Baton Rouge, LA.

The work outlined meets the criteria of the Louisiana-signed SEP Template in that none of the wind and/or solar systems are to exceed the capacity limits identified in the Template (i.e., 20kW for wind and appropriately sized for mounted systems).
