Description:

A11 Technical advice and assistance to organizations

Technical advice and planning assistance to international, national, state, and local organizations.

A9 Information gathering, analysis, and dissemination

Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. B3.14 Small-scale educational facilities

Siting, construction, modification, operation, and decommissioning of small-scale educational facilities (including, but not limited to, conventional teaching laboratories, libraries, classroom facilities, auditoriums, museums, visitor centers, exhibits, and associated offices) within or contiguous to a previously disturbed or developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible). Operation may include, but is not limited to, purchase, installation, and operation of equipment (such as audio/visual and laboratory equipment) commensurate with the educational purpose of the facility.

Rational for determination:

This NEPA determination applies to Phase 2. DOE is proposing to provide federal funding to Pennsylvania State University (PSU) to continue developing the solar "train-the-trainer" program. DOE funds would be used to support the education, training and professional development of solar instructors.

DOE made a previous determination for Phase 1 (GFO-10-213; CX A9 and A11; signed 2.9.2010). Phase 1 included educational development, information gathering, outreach activities, and information dissemination.

PSU proposes to further develop a collaborative process used to train solar instructors. The training would involve co-teaching arrangements for new instructors to gain teaching experience, instructor training courses, expand training to include code and building officials, resource development groups that share best practices and develop collaborative agreements with other Regional Training Providers. Through this process, PSU would refine and expand this training program in partnership with other organizations throughout the Midwest.

Based on this information, DOE has determined the work outlined is consistent with activities identified in categorical exclusion A9 (information gathering), A11 (technical advice and assistance to organization) and B3.14 (small-scale educational facilities).
