Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, site visits, and audits), data analysis (including, but not limited to, computer modeling), document preparation (including, but not limited to, conceptual design, feasibility studies, and analytical energy supply and demand studies), and information dissemination (including, but not limited to, document publication and distribution, and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring. ## Rational for determination:

The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) provided \$234,000 of federal funding to the State of Rhode Island under the DOE's Annually Appropriated State Energy Program (SEP) for 2012. Rhode Island will match the federal funding with \$50,493 in state funds. Additionally, Rhode Island will carryover \$145,500 in federal appropriations and \$29,100, for a total of \$459,093.

Rhode Island proposes to fund the following Market Titles:

## Education and Energy Outreach:

Under this Market Title, funding would be utilized for workshops, the establishment of baseline energy use and production data through a partnership with the University of Rhode Island, website maintenance and upgrades, and outreach and education to rural farms, community and government leaders, students and educators.

## OER Staffing for All Market Titles:

Under this Market Title, funding would be used to support the continuing operation of the SEP activities performed by Rhode Island Energy Office personnel

Based on a review of the activities that would be funded under the above Market Titles, DOE has determined the projects that would be funded under these Market Titles will not significantly impact the human environment and they are categorically excluded from further NEPA review under CX A9 "information gathering," and CX A11 "technical advice."

Any further projects will require a separate NEPA determination review.
