The Office of the Chief Information Officer (OCIO) has maintained a web content filtering solution for Headquarters and DOENet WAN (Rocky Mountain Oilfield Testing Center (RMOTC), SouthEast Power Administration (SEPA), Washington Navy Yard, Golden Field Office, Nevada Site Office (NSO), Office of Legacy Management (Morgantown)), users for almost a decade.

Solution for Web Content Filtering

OCIO selected a Commercial Off-The-Shelf (COTS) web filtering solution as part of a comprehensive risk mitigation strategy. DOE also purchased the COTS vendor's subscription service to receive periodic updates to sites contained within each category based upon the daily evolution of Internet sites.

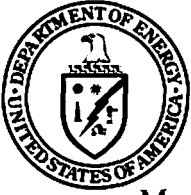

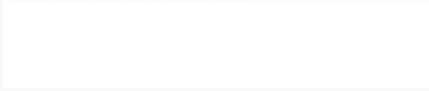

Dear Mr. Kimball:

This is in response to the request for information that you submitted to the Department of Energy under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552, for information concerning remediated sites MV-001, MVO-002, MV-022 and MV-023 at the Monument Valley UMTRA site and the associated Radiological Engineering Assessment and Completion Report, and the Monument No. 2 mine remediation.

Remediation of the Monument No. 2 mine was not performed by the Department of Energy, but was completed by the Navajo Abandoned Mined Lands Reclamation Project, Tuba City Field Office.

As indicated to you in our previous correspondence, the Office of Legacy Management performed a search of all available records and determined that the enclosed documents are responsive to your request as identified in the enclosed index. The documents are being provided to you in their entirety or with portions withheld pursuant to Exemptions 4 and 5 of the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. 552 (b)(4) and (b)(5), respectively.

Exemption (b)(4) protects "trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person and privileged or confidential." Information that is required to be submitted by a person is "confidential" for purposes of Exemption 4 if disclosure is likely to either (1) impair the Government's ability to obtain reliable and high quality necessary information in the future; or (2) cause substantial harm to the competitive position of the person from whom the information is obtained. The information redacted under Exemption 4 is "commercial" or "financial" information because it relates to business activities.

Exemption (b)(5) protects "inter-agency or intra-agency memorandums or letters that would not be available by law to a party in litigation with the agency." It protects those documents normally privileged in the civil discovery context, such as pre-decisional, deliberative process documents. The deliberative process protects advice, recommendations, and opinions that are pre-decisional and part of the decision-making process of the Government. The privilege protects not merely documents but also the integrity of the deliberative process itself where the exposure of that process, or an element thereof, would result in harm.




The FOIA provides for the assessment of fees for the processing of requests of documents. See 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(4)(A)(i); *see also* 10 C.F.R. § 1004.9(a).
