Description: LBL administrative and regulatory records pertaining to the movement and transfer of irradiated elements such as tritium and plutonium. Includes: policies and procedures, correspondence, memoranda, accounting records and reports, Atomic Energy Commission status and investigative reports, licensing requirements, periodic reports on accountability and program operation(e.g., waste disposal and hazard control), committee records, authorization and experimental use proposals and regulations.

The records document the types and amounts of isotope shipments to national and international laboratories. The stated purpose was: "for discovery of new subatomic particles and biomedical research." There are some references to Plowshare and Whitney Projects. The records succinctly documents who and what type of scientific research is being conducted during this ten year period. This is a period of time when the federal government was sponsoring the "Atoms for Peace" initiatives.

All classified materials have been removed from these records.

Disposition: Permanent. Transfer to the National Archives immediately.
