- Capacity of 6 million gallons per year of Fisher-Tropsch (F-T) liquids in the form of renewable sulfur-free diesel fuels and waxes
 - Reclamation of at least 1 trillion BTUs of renewable energy per year of process heat under contract to Flambeau River Papers, which will make FRP the first integrated pulp and paper mill in North America to be fossil fuel free
- Technology and Feedstocks:
- Thermochemical conversion of biomass using advanced gasification technologies followed by F-T catalytic conversion into renewable liquid fuels and waxes
 - Wood and forest residues
- State of Readiness:
- Co-located with an existing Flambeau River Papers pulp and paper mill
 - Estimated to be operational in 2010
