SCOPE

• Address the issues associated with the holes and tears observed in the liner of the Feed Materials Production Center's Waste Pit #5.

ESTABLISHING MILESTONES

- Deadlines for activities required of DOE and Westinghouse are outlined in these Orders.
- DOE and Westinghouse shall submit results of a study to determine the solids loading and solids settling rates of each basin (June 1, 1987), a contingency plan to investigate the environmental impact of Paddy's Run (April 30, 1987), detailed plans and a permit to install application for a stormwater retention system (October 1, 1987), a contingency plan describing actions to minimize potential environmental impacts to Paddy's Run, a best management practices (BMP) plan for the control of industrial wastes and other wastes that may be discharge from the FMPC (March 1, 1988).

- By April 30, 1987, DOE and Westinghouse shall initiate a study of the FMPC discharge to the Great Miami River. By June 1, 1987, DOE and Westinghouse shall submit a scope of work .
- Beginning May 20, 1987 and by the twentieth of every second month, a bi-monthly technical progress report shall be submitted to the Southwest District Office of Ohio EPA describing the progress made to comply with these Orders during the previous two months.

FUNDING

PENALTIES

• No specific monetary penalties are discussed within these Orders.
