2025 Tribal Nation Transmission Program

The Tribal Nation Transmission Program was developed to support Tribal Nations engaging in the planning and development of electricity transmission. The program offers capacity building through educational resources, training, and on-call assistance from energy experts at the National Laboratory of the Rockies.

Project Impacts

In 2025, the Tribal Nation Transmission Program connected **27 Tribal Nations** and **2 Tribal Organizations** with technical experts, training, and to each other to ensure Tribes have a voice in transmission planning. Through direct technical assistance including feasibility assessments, siting support, and strategic energy planning, the program empowers Tribes to shape their transmission and energy infrastructure priorities.
