## Palo Comado Canyon Road Interchange (At Chesebro)

As part of the City's continued efforts to improve vehicular traffic flow affecting local residents, business, and regional visitors the City has completed the design and approval process to enhance the bridge, off-ramps, and surrounding area at the U.S. 101/Palo Comado Canyon Road Interchange at Chesebro Road. The City has received approval from the California Department of Transportation (CalTrans) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) on the Plans, Specifications and Estimates (PS&E), which is the document that provides the detailed plans and design features that have been identified as the best means to address the deficiencies of the interchange and future issues, including traffic safety and flow. The construction phase of the project is estimated at \$13 million.
