The City of Calabasas has prepared a schematic look of the Gateway to the City – the Lost Hills Road Interchange. The new bridge will include architectural and aesthetic elements of the City Hall and additional artistic details such as sculptures of a red tailed hawk, the City logo, and hilly motif of our beautiful area, for Calabasas residents and visitors to enjoy.

The new bridge is projected to be fully open for traffic in March 2018. The City, the contractor, Security Paving Co., and the construction management team, presented by Parsons, are working together to minimize delays and to expedite work on the project.

Below are a few major milestones of the project:

- October 2017 - opening of the west side of the bridge
- October 2017 - closure of temporary access road and Canwood Street opening
- November 2017 - demolition of the old bridge
- March 2018 - completion of the east side of the bridge
- July 2018 - installation of landscaping and project completion
