In accordance with the conditions of DOE/FE Order No. 4521¹ issued April 17, 2020, Commonwealth LNG, LLC ("Commonwealth") hereby submits for filing in the above-referenced docket this semi-annual report as required by ordering Paragraph H, describing the progress of the proposed Commonwealth LNG Export Project ("Project").

On August 20, 2019, Commonwealth filed an application with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("FERC") for authorization to site, construct, and operate the Project in Cameron Parish, Louisiana. Commonwealth is currently engaged with FERC staff to progress its application and is pursuing all other outstanding state and federal authorizations. Based on current schedule, the Project is expected to commence commercial operations by Q2 2025.

Commonwealth LNG has not yet executed any long-term, binding liquefaction agreements or long-term supply agreements, but is actively pursuing negotiations in this regard and will file any executed agreements when available.
