

FREE CYBER SECURITY TRAINING FOR THE UTILITY WORKFORCE

The Department of Energy's Office of Cybersecurity, Energy Security, and Emergency Response (CESER) is hosting cybersecurity training events specifically for the electric subsector in partnership with Idaho National Laboratory (INL). Each training event will provide 3 days of lectures and hands on exercises and challenges.



Hands-On Training from Expert Instructors

Leading practitioners in the ICS/OT cybersecurity industry will provide lectures and hands-on training using real ICS equipment.



Training in All Six NERC Regions

Each training event will cover the same material and one event will be located in each of the six NERC regions. Registration priority is provided to electric utility staff. Participants do not need to be from a NERC registered entity.



Investing in Critical Infrastructure

These cybersecurity training events are supported by the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL). The BIL appropriates more than \$62 billion to the U.S. DOE to invest in secure, reliable, clean, and affordable power.
