**Details**

I ( (b)(6) ) spotted what I believed to looked like a drone flying West to East over Sandia National Laboratory. I confirmed with (b)(6) if that could be a drone and he replied it could be. It was low flying and had no sound with alternating white and red LED lighting. Sandia SIMs office called me at Vasco Post and said they had spotted a low flying jet that made no sound flying over Sandia around the same time. The drone continued to fly East until it was out of sight. I notified the Central Alarm Station of what I saw.
