

NOTICE OF DENIAL OF REHEARING BY OPERATION OF LAW AND
PROVIDING FOR FURTHER CONSIDERATION
(June 1, 2026)

Rehearing has been timely requested of the Department of Energy's order issued on March 30, 2026, in the above-captioned matter.¹ Thirty (30) days having passed from the date on which rehearing requests were filed, the requests for rehearing are deemed denied by operation of law.²
