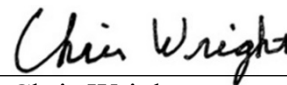

**NOTICE OF DENIAL OF REHEARING BY OPERATION OF LAW
AND PROVIDING FOR FURTHER CONSIDERATION
(July 20, 2026)**

Rehearing has been timely requested of the Department of Energy's order issued on May 18, 2026, in the above-captioned matter.¹ Thirty (30) days having passed from the date on which rehearing requests were filed, the requests for rehearing are deemed denied by operation of law.²

As provided in 16 U.S.C. § 825l(a) and 16 U.S.C. § 824a(c), the requests for rehearing of the above-cited order may be addressed in a future order.³
