Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph J of DOE/FE Order No. 3867¹, and Ordering Paragraph M of DOE/FE Order No. 4445², Eagle LNG Partners Jacksonville LLC (“Eagle LNG”) submits its semi-annual report providing the progress of the proposed liquefaction facility.

Eagle LNG has received from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission an order authorizing Eagle LNG to site, construct, and operate the facility, but the facility has not yet commenced construction. Eagle LNG is continuing to progress commercial discussions with potential off-takers.
