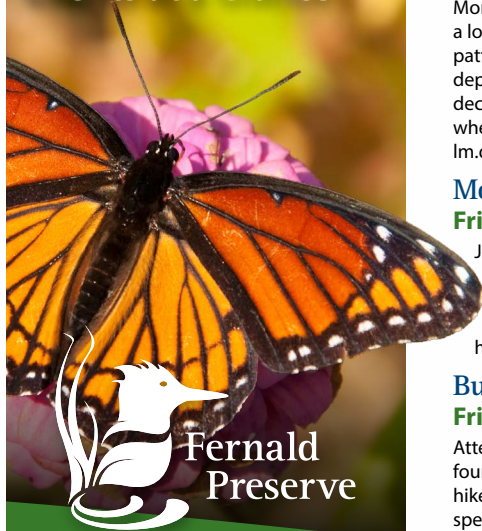

MAPS Bird Banding May-August

Monitoring Avian Productivity and Survivorship, or MAPS, is a long-running study of breeding birds and their dispersal pattern across the country. Because of the weather-dependent nature of this program, dates and times will be decided on a week-by-week basis — sign up to be notified when this program will be taking place. Moths and Mars Friday, July 10, 8:30 p.m.-midnight

Join Fernald staff and the Cincinnati Astronomical Society for a presentation on Mars. Afterwards, hang around the building with volunteers and their telescopes (so long as the skies are clear) or join Fernald staff on a 1-2 mile hike around the Shingle Oak Trail to look for moths!

Butterflies of Fernald Friday, July 17, 7-8:30 p.m.

Attend a presentation on just some of the butterflies to be found around the preserve. Afterwards, take a short 1-mile hike around Shingle Oak Trail with butterfly nets to see what species we can find.

Fish of Fernald Saturday, July 18, 9 a.m.-noon

Attend a short presentation about the fish swimming in Paddys Run Creek, located on the western side of Fernald. Afterwards, take a 1-mile hike to watch our site ecologist survey the creek. This hike will cover unpaved and uneven trails, so sturdy shoes are a must for participants. (Preregistration is required.)

Adult Science Night: World of Water Friday, July 24, 6-7:30 p.m.

Play with water from the comfort of our shelter and meeting room with fun experiments and activities. Try your hand at our H₂O-lympics, take an incredible journey through the water cycle, and conduct a tabletop experiment illustrating groundwater sampling. This program is targeted toward an 18+ audience.

Boardwalk Night Hike Friday, July 31, 9-11 p.m.

Join us on a night hike to the boardwalk and back under the stars as we listen for owls and whatever other nighttime critters we might cross paths with.
