# *WIPP Shut Down*

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- WIPP Event Occurred February 5 and February 14
- All TRU Waste Shipments were stopped February 5
- WIPP scheduled maintenance outage (February 10-March 10)
- Impacts to Idaho Cleanup Project



# *Impacts to Idaho Cleanup Project*

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## **Contact Handled (CH)-TRU (Transuranic) Waste**






- Operations at AMWTP will continue with adjustments
  - TRU Waste payloads will continue to be assembled and placed in backlog
  - MLLW payloads will continue to be assembled and shipped out of the State of Idaho
- Storage space will become a premium
  - Current storage space is 70% full
  - Ship out MLLW to increase storage space
  - Disposition Cargo Containers to increase storage space
  - Look at creating additional storage space

## **Remote Handled (RH ) TRU Waste**

- Operations at INTEC will continue as normal
  - Backlog of shipments is zero
  - Storage capacity available to cover two years of production with no issues
