Access Instructions

Access Overview

To enter the Kansas City National Security Campus (KCNSC), you must have an approved badge. Before you arrive, you will need to submit your personal information for a security background check and bring a valid Real ID or Homeland Security Presidential Directive 12 (HSPD-12) badge. You can pick up your official badge at the badging office on campus.

If you already have an HSPD-12 badge from another DOE/NNSA site, you may pre-register your badge three to five business days before your visit. You may also pre-register for site access through the [KCNSC Physical Access Request System](#) or the [OneNNSAccess portal](#).

Important Steps

- With your HSPD-12 badge, pre-register for your visit through the [OneNNSAccess portal](#).
- Contact your KCNSC host to determine if your visit requires enhanced access control authorizations.
- Bring your HSPD-12 badge with you.
- Visit the KCNSC badging office in the lobby if you encounter any badge issues.
- Your badge must be visible and always worn while on-site.

For those unable to pre-register online, or who do not have an HSPD-12 badge, please visit the badging office before your visit. For questions about visitor registration or badge access, please contact D-X10@kcncs.doe.gov.

Attire Recommendations

Visitors should expect a significant amount of walking during their time on campus, so comfortable footwear is recommended. Please note that open-toed shoes, open-heeled shoes, and heels exceeding 2 inches are strictly prohibited in all manufacturing areas. Additionally, visitors entering manufacturing spaces must wear long pants and a safety breakaway lanyard.
