To Whom It May Concern:

On March 3, 2023, the U.S. Department of Energy, Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management (“DOE/FECM”) issued NFE Altamira FLNG, S. de R.L. de C.V. (“NFE Altamira”) an Order Granting Long-Term Authorization to Export Natural Gas to Mexico and to Other Free Trade Agreement Nations (“Order No. 4960”).<sup>1</sup> On August 31, 2024, DOE/FECM issued NFE Altamira an Order Granting Long-Term Authorization to Re-Export U.S.-Sourced Natural Gas in the Form of Liquefied Natural Gas from Mexico to Non-Free Trade Agreement Nations (“Order No. 5156”).<sup>2</sup> Order Nos. 4960 and 5156 authorized NFE Altamira to export U.S.-sourced natural gas by pipeline from the United States to Mexico and, after liquefaction in Mexico, to re-export the U.S.-sourced natural gas in the form of liquefied natural gas (“LNG”) by vessel from a floating liquefaction and export terminal proposed by NFE Altamira’s affiliate, Mexico FLNG S. de R.L. de C.V., off the coast of Altamira Tamaulipas, Mexico (“Project”).

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Conditions J and H of Order Nos. 4960 and 5156, respectively, require that NFE Altamira file semi-annual reports (on or before April 1 and October 1 of each year) on the status of the Project. NFE Altamira hereby submits this semi-annual report covering the period October 1, 2025 through March 31, 2026.

**(i) Status of Permits Required Under Mexican State and Federal Laws for the Siting, Construction and Operation of the Project and for Re-export of LNG**

The Project obtained all required material regulatory permits for the construction, installation and operation of the Project and for the export of natural gas from FLNG 1 (the first stage of the Project which was commissioned and placed in-service on August 9, 2024).

**(ii) Information on the Operation of the Project**

NFE Altamira continued to re-export LNG from the Project to free trade agreement and non-free trade agreement nations during the reporting period.

**(iii) The Status of Any Associated Long-term Supply and Re-export Contracts**

NFE Altamira has not entered into additional long-term supply or re-export contracts during the reporting period.
