Access Instructions

How to Register

Considering a visit to Y-12 through [OneNNSAccess \(ONA\)](#)? Here are a few things you want to know before you go:

- Confirm your Homeland Security Presidential Directive 12 (HSPD-12) credentials are current.
- Visit the Y-12 ONA [Visitor Registration Portal](#) to enroll with your HSPD-12 badge.
- Ensure that your identity information is accurate.
- Visitors must have a Q-clearance and be a U.S. citizen to enroll.
- Check your email for confirmation from Y-12 Visitor Services on next steps. Note: ONA is only valid for access to New Hope Center (NHC) and Jack Case Center (JCC). For access to other areas of the site, you must visit the Y-12 Visitor Services at NHC.

When You Arrive

Comply with the following speed limits, unless otherwise posted:

- Bear Creek Road – 35 mph
- Interior Roadways – 25 mph
- Parking Areas – 15 mph

Visitors should not use cellular devices, including hands-free, or portable electronic devices, while operating a vehicle.

Before You Arrive

Y-12 plays an integral role in our nation's nuclear defense policies, and we have some of the most stringent security in the world. We ask that you become acquainted with our most basic security and safety rules and procedures before visiting.

Y-12 prohibits the introduction, transportation, or possession of weapons, explosives, or other instruments likely to produce substantial injury to persons or property. This restriction includes:

- Items prohibited by local, state or federal law.
- Controlled substances (i.e., illegal drugs and associated paraphernalia).
- Privately owned explosive chemicals and devices.
- Privately owned handguns or rifles of any make or model, including air-powered.
- Knives with blades 2.5 inches or longer.
- Privately owned ammunitions/projectiles (e.g., bullets, rockets, arrows, etc., that could be discharged from a weapon).
- Items that could be used to start fires, excluding personal lighters. (Heavy equipment may have up to 10 road flares and personal vehicles may have up to 5 road flares).



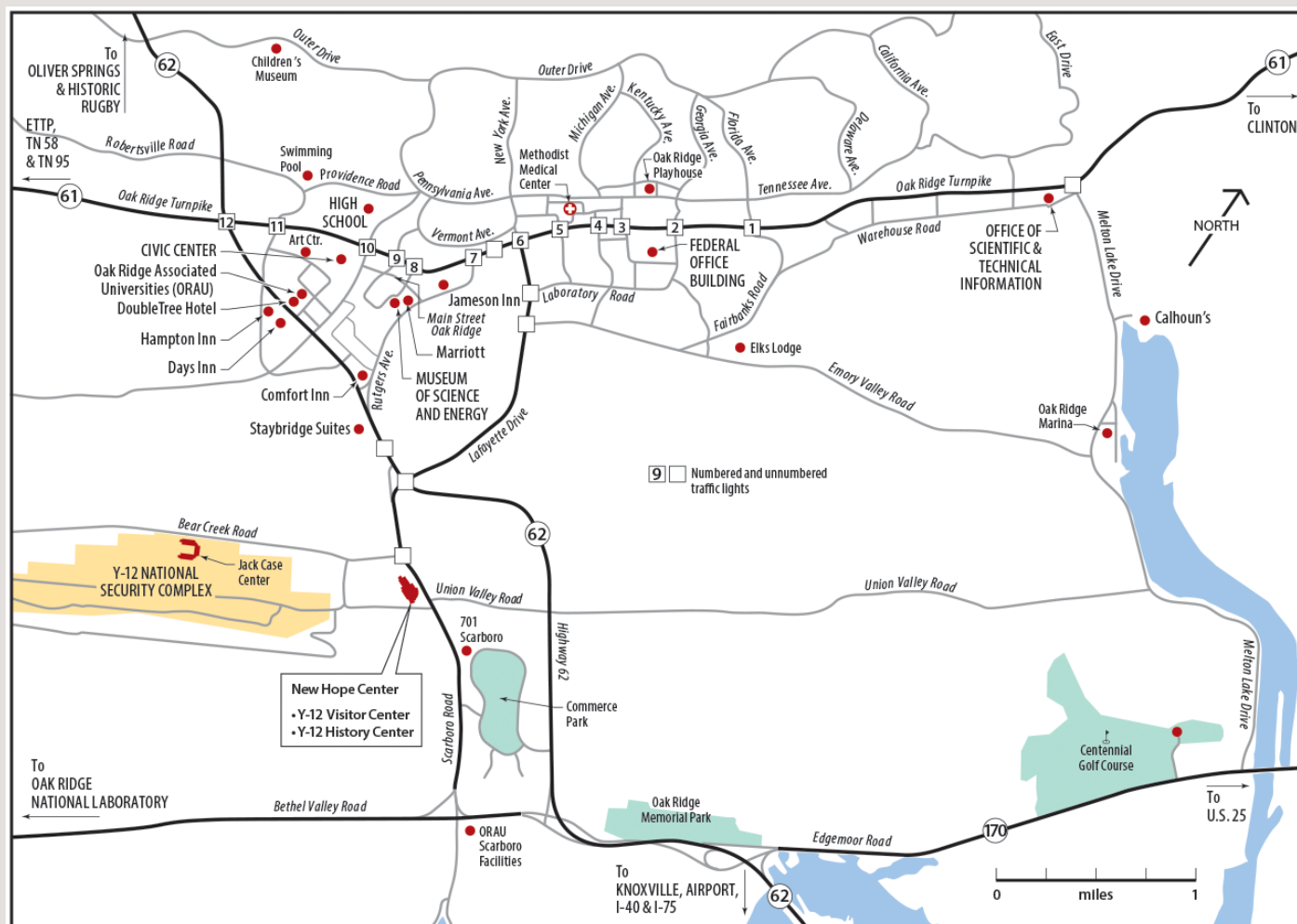
U.S. DEPARTMENT
