

Relevant Statutory Guidance

Residential Adoption (42 U.S.C. 6833(a)(5)(B))

Each State is required to certify that it has compared its residential building code regarding energy efficiency to the revised model code and submit a determination as to whether it is appropriate to revise its code to meet or exceed the successor code.

Commercial Adoption (42 U.S.C. 6833(b)(2)(B)(i))

Each State is required to certify that it has reviewed and updated its commercial building code regarding energy efficiency in accordance with the revised model code.

Technical Assistance (42 U.S.C. 6833(d))

DOE shall provide technical assistance to States to implement the requirements of this section, and to improve and implement State residential and commercial building energy efficiency codes.




BECP Adoption and Implementation Goals

- Ensure intended energy savings through code compliance verification




Status of Residential Adoption
