- ADEP completes repackaging TRU waste
- “Plan B” storage at WCS while WIPP recovers. Shipping starts in April.
- Permit renewal application for IP for storm water to EPA 3/26 – 450 sites to ~200 sites. Controls are working, sites cleaned up.
- Monitoring well pump testing report to NMED w/ proposed plan for pilot pumping.
- Recovery for September flood event 1/3 complete. Work continues through this summer.
