

SUMMARY

The Office of Regulation and International Engagement, Division of Natural Gas Regulation prepares quarterly reports on natural gas import and export activities. Companies are required, as a condition of their authorizations, to file monthly reports. This Natural Gas Import and Export Report is for the first quarter of 2018 (January through March).

Sections 1 and 2 contain quarterly summary charts, tables, and a map displaying U.S. LNG exports by vessel. Section 3 contains the detailed transactions of all imports and exports. The data in Section 3 are organized by activity: long-term imports, long-term exports, short-term imports, and short-term exports. Section 4 lists revisions made to data published previously. There is a table of contents for your convenience.

First Quarter 2018 Highlights

The January through March months saw the lower-48 states export a total of 237.5 Bcf of LNG (including shipments of LNG in cryogenic ISO containers, not including re-exports) through the Sabine Pass LNG and the Cove Point LNG export facilities during the first quarter. The Countries of Destination Table shows the destinations for these 69 LNG by vessel cargos, not including ISO container shipments. American LNG Marketing, also continued its smaller shipments of LNG in cryogenic ISO containers, exporting 84,570 Mcf in 32 cargos to Barbados and Bahamas, from Fort Lauderdale, Florida and Doral, Florida.

U.S. imports totaled 846.9 Bcf and U.S. exports totaled 867.2 Bcf, resulting in net U.S. exports of 20.3 Bcf. As usual, most of the imports by pipeline came from Canada, comprising 96.3 percent of the total imports. LNG imports (truck and vessel) and U.S. imports from Mexico made up the remainder, 3.7 percent of total imports. Mexico eclipsed Canada in total natural gas by U.S. pipeline exports, with 45.3 percent going to Mexico and 27.3 percent to Canada. Total U.S. exports by pipeline equal 72.6 percent of total U.S. exports, with the remaining 27.4 percent of total U.S. exports being very small volumes of LNG trucked exports to Canada and Mexico, as well as LNG by vessel cargos (including ISO containers) to the countries listed in the Countries of Destination Table.

First Quarter 2018 vs. Fourth Quarter 2017 - Highlights

As illustrated in the tables in Section 1, total imports increased 6.9 percent compared to last quarter. Pipeline imports from Canada increased by 5.1 percent, while pipeline imports from Mexico increased by 59.6 percent (although from a very small initial volume base). LNG imports by vessel increased 97.6 percent. Canadian imports by pipeline prices were up 19.1 percent from last quarter while Mexican imports by pipeline prices were also up by 27.3 percent from last quarter. LNG import by vessel prices rose by 113.2 percent.

Total U.S. exports were 867.2 Bcf, 0.2 percent lower than the fourth quarter 2017 total. A 2.4 percent decrease in U.S. exports by pipeline to Mexico was complemented by a 5.8 percent increase in U.S. exports by pipeline to Canada. Prices of U.S. pipeline exports to Mexico increased by 1.6 percent while prices of U.S. pipeline exports to Canada increased by 13.4 percent.

Additionally, there were 101 domestic LNG exports by vessel (including ISO containers, not including re-exports) this quarter, 237.5 Bcf with cargos being shipped to the countries listed in the Countries of Destination Table. Total trucked U.S. import volumes (for LNG and CNG) decreased by 51.0 percent while total trucked export volumes (for LNG and CNG) decreased by 8.5 percent in the first quarter when compared with the fourth quarter

2017. Total trucked U.S. export prices (for LNG and CNG) increased by 7.2 percent and import prices (for LNG and CNG) increased by 9.6 percent, compared to last quarter.

First Quarter 2018 vs. First Quarter 2017 – Highlights

Total U.S. imports were down 0.7 percent from the first quarter of 2017. Pipeline imports from Canada decreased 1.3 percent, pipeline imports from Mexico also increased by a 340.1 percent (although from a small base), and LNG imports by vessel increased 13.4 percent. The average price of pipeline imports fell 0.2 percent and LNG by vessel import prices rose 24.9 percent. Trucked imports increased 43.5 percent from last year (although from a small base), with those prices rising 12.9 percent on average.

Total U.S. exports rose 8.6 percent compared to the first quarter of 2017. U.S. pipeline exports to Canada decreased by 17.2 percent and U.S. pipeline exports to Mexico increased by 7.4 percent. Total U.S. trucked exports increased by 5.1 percent. Overall, U.S. exports by pipeline decreased by 3.4 percent while prices increased 1.9 percent, compared to the first quarter of 2017.

Imports and Exports of LNG by Vessel

LNG imports by vessel rose 97.6 percent compared to last quarter and rose 13.4 percent compared to the first quarter of 2017. Fourteen LNG cargos (29.8 Bcf) were imported by vessel this quarter, compared to nine cargos (19.4 Bcf) in the fourth quarter of 2017 and 15 cargos (26.3 Bcf) in the first quarter of 2017. LNG import prices by vessel were 113.2 percent higher than the last quarter and 24.9 percent higher than in the first quarter of 2017.

There were 101 exports of domestically-produced LNG (including ISO containers, not including re-exports) in this quarter (237.5 Bcf), compared to 84 in the last quarter (242.6 Bcf) and 59 cargos in the first quarter of 2017 (146.7 Bcf). The U.S. did not re-export any cargos of LNG in this quarter (0 Bcf), and re-exported one cargo in the last quarter (0.4 Bcf). No re-exports were shipped in the first quarter of 2017.

During this quarter, five LNG cargos were delivered to Puerto Rico (11.2 Bcf), compared to three in the fourth quarter 2017 (6.6 Bcf) and six in the first quarter of 2017 (12.8 Bcf).



1st Quarter 2018











(\$/MMBtu)




- In the first quarter of 2018, the U.S. imported 846.9 Bcf of natural gas.
- A large majority of imports originated in Canada, continuing a long-term trend. Trinidad and Tobago was the next-largest supplier, providing 2.8 percent of imports.
- The remaining volume was supplied by three other countries – the United Kingdom, France, and Mexico.
- Import prices averaged in the range of \$2.87 per MMBtu from Canada to \$12.28 per MMBtu for LNG from the United Kingdom.

Avg. Export Price (pipeline and truck), 1Q2018 (\$/MMBtu)





- About 62 percent of U.S. exports by pipeline and truck of domestically-produced natural gas during the first quarter were sent to Mexico, while 38 percent were sent to Canada.
- Prices of exports by pipeline and truck to Mexico and Canada mirrored each other at \$3.35 per MMBtu for Mexico and \$3.34 per MMBtu for Canada.

Total Exports – 237.5 Bcf






- U.S. LNG exports by vessel to Korea, Mexico, and China make up about 61 percent of U.S. LNG exports during the first quarter, with a very small volume of less than one percent being U.S. exports by ISO container to Barbados and the Bahama Islands.

- Prices of exports ranged from as low as \$3.03 per MMBtu to the Dominican Republic and as high as \$7.18 per MMBtu to Brazil for U.S. LNG exports by vessel in the first quarter, while the U.S. LNG exports by ISO (Barbados and Bahama Islands) container averaged \$10 per MMBTu.


Comparison of 1Q2018 Imports with Previous Quarters

- The total volume of first quarter imports is higher than the fourth quarter of 2017, but is lower than the first quarter of 2017.
- The increase in imports relative to the fourth quarter of 2017 is due to an increase in imports from Canada and LNG by vessel. Imports from Mexico remained at a very low level.


Comparison of 1Q2018 Exports with Previous Quarters

- Export volumes in the first quarter were lower than the fourth quarter of 2017 and higher than the first quarter of 2017.
- Exports to Canada by pipeline and truck were higher in the first quarter of 2018 than in the fourth quarter of 2017 but were lower than the first quarter of 2017.
- Exports to Mexico by pipeline and truck in the first quarter of 2018 were lower than the fourth quarter of 2017 and higher than the first quarter of 2017.





- Volumes of natural gas imported under short-term authorizations during the first quarter continued to eclipse volumes imported under long-term authorizations at all entry points, with the exception of Calais, Maine where long-term volumes are marginally higher.
- Eastport, Idaho experienced the highest volume of imports from Canada, at 24.1 percent of the total. Sherwood, North Dakota and Port of Morgan, Montana had the second and third largest import volumes, accounting for 19.3 percent and 14.6 percent of the total, respectively. These three points, along with Sumas, Washington, Noyes, Minnesota, and Waddington, New York handled over 92 percent of all imports from Canada during the first quarter.
- Continuing a trend of negligible imports from Mexico in recent years, only a small volume of natural gas was brought into the country from Mexico, through three entry points, during the first quarter.

(Bcf)



- St. Clair, Michigan continued to handle most exports by pipeline to Canada – more than 55 percent for the first quarter – with Niagara Falls, New York handling nearly 23 percent of the pipeline exports to Canada.
- There were no exports to Canada under long-term authorizations in the third quarter.

- The United States continued to export natural gas to Mexico through a large number of exit points using short-term authorizations during the first quarter. However, over 54 percent of the gas transited two points: Rio Grande City, Texas and Roma, Texas.
- There were also smaller volume of gas exported through long-term authorizations.
- Rio Grande City, Texas is the largest point of export to Mexico.

LNG Import Volume (vessel) by Country 1Q2018



LNG Import Volume (vessel) by Terminal 1Q2018


