Enforcement Policy Statement – Rough Service Lamps and Vibration Service Lamps

Issued: February 7, 2018

In an exercise of its enforcement discretion, DOE will not seek civil penalties concerning violations related to the energy conservation standards established in 10 C.F.R.§ 430.32(bb) with respect to the distribution in commerce of a rough service lamp or vibration service lamp manufactured on or after January 25, 2018, but before May 1, 2018, provided that the lamp is:

(1) manufactured in fulfillment of a contractual obligation entered into prior to December

26, 2017, to manufacture lamps to specifications not in compliance with those

standards; or

(2) manufactured in the United States with specialized component parts, procured prior to

December 26, 2017, that can only be used in the manufacture of lamps to specifications

not in compliance with those standards.

This policy does not create or remove any rights or duties and does not affect any other

aspect of EPCA or DOE regulations.
