Project Title: Install Fence Flagging at the Gunnison, Colorado, Disposal Site

Location: Gunnison, Colorado, Uranium Mill Tailings Raditation Control Act Title I Site

Proposed Action or Project Description:

LM is proposing to install fence flagging as a wildlife habitat improvement at the Gunnison site. The proposed action is intended to enhance wildlife habitat at the Gunnison site. Fence flags will be installed around the perimeter of the site to make the fence more visible to Gunnison Sage-grouse, a species federally listed as threatened. Flags are 3 by 3 inches in size, made of extruded vinyl with reflector tape. Flagging will be clipped to the top two strands of fence wire at approximately 2 foot spacing, alternating between the top and second strand. The total length of the cell perimeter fence is 1.6 miles. In accordance with U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service guidelines, fencing will be installed between July 16, 2019, and March 14, 2020.
