Description:

- A9 Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, audits), data analysis (including computer modeling), document preparation (such as conceptual design or feasibility studies, analytical energy supply and demand studies), and dissemination (including, but not limited to, document mailings, publication, and distribution; and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring.

One mock up roof would be used as a hands-on training equipment under this award. The mock up roof is not a permanent structure but an assemble/disassemble structure that is usually stored inside and is taken out during the training.
