Based on my review of the information concerning the proposed action, as NEPA Compliance Officer (authorized under DOE Order 451.1A), I have made the following determination:

Description:

- Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, audits), data analysis (including computer modeling), document preparation (such as conceptual design or feasibility studies, analytical energy supply and demand studies), and dissemination (including, but not limited to, document mailings, publication, and distribution; and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring.

- B3.1 Onsite and offsite site characterization and environmental monitoring, including siting, construction (or modification), operation, and dismantlement or closing (abandonment) of characterization and monitoring devices and siting, construction, and associated operation of a small-scale laboratory building or renovation of a room in an existing building for sample analysis. Activities covered include, but are not limited to, site characterization and environmental monitoring under CERCLA and RCRA. Specific activities include, but are not limited to:

Rational for determination:

New School & Performing Arts is proposing to install a Ground Source Heat Pump system to service the New School & Performing Arts School. However this project is in the process of conducting their feasibility study and has yet to select a Ground Source Heat Pump system. Therefore DOE will issue a determination for Phase 1 "Feasibility Study and Engineering Design" of the project; including the drilling of a test conductivity borehole. Phase 2 "Installation & Commissioning of Equipment" will require further NEPA review immediately following test well data and conceptual system design. DOE will require all information collected during Phase 1 to be submitted to the Department for further NEPA review before project implementation can occur.

This information gathering presents no significant environmental impact and therefore this task is Categorically Excluded under CX A9 "Information Gathering" and CX A11 "technical advice" from further NEPA review. The drilling of the test conductivity borehole will be drilled a previously disturbed area on the school's grounds adjacent to the school. The test well will be an integral part of the feasibility study. The test borehole will then be used to conduct thermal conductivity testing on the soil, this will determine the system's heating and cooling potential which will then be compared to the baseline of the buildings heating and cooling needs and a system will be designed with these demands. There are no known drinking water aquifers used in this part of the city and the test well will comply with the Pennsylvania Well Water Drilling Regulations and a licensed well driller will be used.

The drilling of a test conductivity borehole is therefore determined to have no significant impact to human health and/or environment and is hereby Categorically Excluded from further NEPA review under B3.1 "Environmental Montoring and Site Characterization".

If you move forward with activities that are not authorized for federal funding by the DOE Contracting Officer in advance of the final NEPA decision, you are doing so at risk of not receiving federal funding and such costs may not be recognized as allowable cost share.
