The activities are related to education, outreach, and regulatory issues and do not include any demonstration activities.

- 1. Deliver the Solar Now! toolkit to six new communities, including Portland neighborhoods and other interested Oregon cities;
- 2. Facilitate neighborhood-based volume purchasing of solar energy systems in four Portland neighborhoods;
- 3. Incorporate a residential solar power purchase agreement into Portland's newest clean energy financing program, called Clean Energy Works Portland;
- Remove barriers to neighborhood-scale energy solutions.

The project does not include any capital, construction, equipment purchase or installation or design services.

The project comprises information dissemination, technical advice, and planning assistance, therefore it qualifies for a CX under A9 and A11.
