Rational for determination:

This project is categorically excluded from further NEPA review for the following reasons:

• The majority of the tasks proposed in this project (Tasks 1, 2, 5, and 6) are related to information gathering/data analysis/document preparation/dissemination and geological/geophysical surveys. As such, they qualify for categorical exclusion under CX A9. Task 3 involves the drilling of 7.5 meter deep, 5 cm diameter holes on existing disturbance, and placing sensors in them (see Project Narrative.pdf, Figure 3); and Task 4 involves geophysical techniques (ground penetrating radar). Therefore categorical exclusion B 3.1 applies.

· All field research would be conducted at the established Altona Flat Rock in Northeastern New York State (Altona. NY), an experimental site where extensive tracer experiments have been conducted. The Altona Flat Rock Reseach Site was established in 1994 and is supported by an onsite trailer that houses room for laboratory work and equipment storage.

· Permits would be obtained, presumably from the State of New York for the use of non-hazardous tracers in the

• This site has an existing array of 5 shallow wells in an X pattern, 10 meters on a side. All wells intersect a horizontal bedding-plane fracture approximately 8 meters below the surface. Flow and behavior of the tracers will be measured in this highly constrained, natural environment. To further constrain the test, tracer tests are coupled with periodic hydraulic tests that examine the exchange of fluid between primary flow paths and secondary "stagnant" water in the fractures.

Boreholes would be drilled using a portable drill rig will drill 8-12, these would be 2 in diameter boreholes from the surface to 7.5 m depth. Hot water would be circulated through the fracture heat exchange and would be monitored using temperature probes.
