## CX, EA, EIS APPENDIX AND NUMBER:

Description:

- B3.6 Siting, construction (or modification), operation, and decommissioning of facilities for indoor bench-scale research projects and conventional laboratory operations (for example, preparation of chemical standards and sample analysis); small-scale research and development projects; and small-scale pilot projects (generally less than two years) conducted to verify a concept before demonstration actions. Construction (or modification) will be within or contiguous to an already developed area (where active utilities and currently used roads are readily accessible).
- A9 Information gathering (including, but not limited to, literature surveys, inventories, audits), data analysis (including computer modeling), document preparation (such as conceptual design or feasibility studies, analytical energy supply and demand studies), and dissemination (including, but not limited to, document mailings, publication, and distribution; and classroom training and informational programs), but not including site characterization or environmental monitoring.

### Rational for determination:

DOE is proposing to provide federal funding to UOP to construct and operate a pilot-scale integrated biorefinery that would process one dry ton per day of biomass using pyrolysis and subsequent upgrading to transportation fuels.

This NEPA determination is for Budget Period 1 (BP1) only. Budget period 1 activities include project management, NEPA documentation for Budget Period 2 activities, permitting, preliminary design, bench scale research and development, life cycle assessments for various feedstock, feedstock characterization.

CX A9 applies to preliminary design, permitting, NEPA and paper study activities.

CX B3.6 applies to research and development activities.

BP1 does not include final design, construction / operation, or capital purchases. All final design, construction, capital equipment purchase/installation and operation activities are subject to further NEPA review.

## NEPA PROVISION

DOE has made a conditional NEPA determination for this award, and funding for certain tasks under this award is contingent upon the final NEPA determination.

Insert the following language in the award:

You are restricted from taking any action using federal funds, which would have an adverse affect on the environment or limit the choice of reasonable alternatives prior to DOE/NNSA providing either a NEPA clearance or a final NEPA decision regarding the project.

#### Prohibited actions include:

Final design, construction / operation, and capital equipment purchases are prohibited at this time. All final design, construction / operation, and capital equipment purchase/installation activities are subject to further NEPA review.

This restriction does not preclude you from:

Budget Period 1 activites.

If you move forward with activities that are not authorized for federal funding by the DOE Contracting Officer in advance of the final NEPA decision, you are doing so at risk of not receiving federal funding and such costs may not be recognized as allowable cost share.
