Description:

B5.1 Actions to conserve energy, demonstrate potential energy conservation, and promote energy-efficiency that do not increase the indoor concentrations of potentially harmful substances. These actions may involve financial and technical assistance to individuals (such as builders, owners, consultants, designers), organizations (such as utilities), and state and local governments. Covered actions include, but are not limited to: programmed lowering of thermostat settings, placement of timers on hot water heaters, installation of solar hot water systems, installation of efficient lighting, improvements in generator efficiency and appliance efficiency ratings, development of energy-efficient manufacturing or industrial practices, and small-scale conservation and renewable energy research and development and pilot projects. The actions could involve building renovations or new structures in commercial, residential, agricultural, or industrial sectors. These actions do not include rulemakings, standard-settings, or proposed DOE legislation.

Rational for determination:

CalStar Products, Inc., a producer of fly ash bricks and pavers, will receive \$1,300,000 in Recovery Act funds under the State of Wisconsin's Job Creation and Retention through Clean Energy Advanced Manufacturing Market Title. The funds will be used by the company to purchase energy efficient automated packaging machines in its Caledonia factory. The company is matching \$4 million in working capital and equipment. CalStar's fly ash is sourced from the nearby We Energies' Oak Creek coal fired power plant. Use of Recovery Act funds for the purchase of new packaging machines for this facility is considered "retooling" and supports activities that recycle waste products. The project will not expand the footprint of the existing building and no construction or repairs of the building will be undertaken as part of the project. The project requires no new permitting or licensing.

In view of the information provided by the State, that the recipient has ensured the State of their commitment to abide by any applicable State waste stream requirements and protection of historical resources per Section 106 of NHPA, that the project will not impact the footprint of the facility, that the nature of the work will not significantly impact plant operations, and that the project converts waste stream material into a marketable product thus alleviating a burden on landfill disposal, I have determined that the project is classified as Categorical Exclusion B5.1.
